Community Organizations applying MUST be a non-profit. All Applications must be accompanied by a description of the activity or informational items that you plan to have in your booth. If you are doing a fundraiser, items must be antiques or handmade items, no MLM items are allowed. If you be preparing and/or serving food, must include a copy of their Certification of Insurance and obtain certification from the Delaware County Board of Health Department (contact: 765-747-7721). If your application is accepted, you will be notified within 2-3 weeks after your application is received. **Applications are first come first serve and space is only secured when payment is made.** Submit your application with your Check, Money Order, or fill out this application online and submit payment at www.oldwashingtonstreetfestival.org. Applications will close September 1, 2024. Pre-payment of booth fee is required with your application and is non-refundable upon acceptance. The Festival is "Rain or Shine" no packing up before 5:00 pm. NO WHEELED vendor trailers are permitted in the arts/crafts, demonstration, historically appropriate, or non-profit informational areas. ALL VENDORS must follow the OWSF Guidelines and Policies. Applications will not be accepted after September 1, 2024.

Hateful conduct, abuse, and harassment are always prohibited at the Old Washington Street Festival. The Festival has a zero tolerance policy for the expression of hate toward any group or individual. We define hateful conduct as attacks on individuals or groups based on protected characteristics, including race, ethnicity, color, national origin, religion, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, age, familial status, or disability. Any such expressions of hate will result in exclusion or removal from the Festival.
